STEEL, TIN

- ✓ **steel/tin cans**
-rinsed and lables removed

- ✗ cardboard cans
- ✗ metalized-look plastics
- ✗ aerosol cans, wire strapping
- ✗ aluminum foil, meat & pie tins

GLASS

- ✓ **pop/juice/beer bottles**
-clear, brown, green, and blue
-emptied and sorted by color
- ✓ **food containers**
-clear and brown
-emptied, rinsed, and sorted by color
-remove lids, lables may remain

- ✗ ceramic dishes/ clay pots
- ✗ light bulbs
- ✗ window panes, mirrors
- ✗ drinking glasses, crystal

PLASTIC

- ✓ **plastics #1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7**
- ✓ **soft drink bottles**
- ✓ **milk/water/juice jugs**
- ✓ **ketchup/condiment bottles**
- ✓ **cooking oil bottles**
- ✓ **ice cream pails** *(remove handle)*
- ✓ **shampoo/conditioner bottles**
- ✓ **liquid detergent bottles**
- ✓ **motor oil bottles**
-DO NOT RINSE - Drain for +24hrs
- ✓ **Antifreeze/washer fluid bottles**

- ✗ plastics w/o recycle symbol and # 1 - 7
- ✗ plastic bags *(grocery, bread, sandwich)*
- ✗ styrofoam food containers/cups
- ✗ paint, solvent & adhesive bottles
- ✗ stretch wrap & flexible wrap
- ✗ disposable diapers
- ✗ silage bags
- ✗ toys

NEWSPAPER/CARDBOARD/MAGAZINES

- ✓ **newspaper and inserts**
- ✓ **corrugated cardboard**
-flatten
- ✓ **paperboard**
-flatten

- ✗ magazines
- ✗ phone books
- ✗ office paper

Above are the acceptable recyclable materials. Recyclable materials can be placed in blue bins. Aluminum cans (emptied and preferably not flattened) can be recycled inside shed on site. Recycling is free and provided by the Townships of Motley and Scandia Valley. Collection sites, hours, and days of operation are located on the other side of this page.
