Acceptable Construction and Demolition Debris

- Bituminous concrete (includes asphalt pavement & blacktop)
- Concrete (including rebar)
- Stone
- Uncontaminated Soil
- Masonry (bricks, stucco & plaster)
- Untreated wood (including painted, stained and/or varnished dimensional lumber, pallets, tree stumps, grubbing, root balls, particle board, plywood, fencing and dock materials)
- Siding (includes vinyl, masonite, untreated wood, aluminum and steel)
- Wall coverings
- Electrical wiring and components
- Roofing materials*
- Duct work*
- Wall board & sheetrock
- Built-in cabinetry
- Plumbing fixtures
- **Affixed** carpet & padding
- Ceramic and cast iron items
- Conduit & pipes (includes PVC)
- Glass (limited to window & door glass from buildings and structures)
- Insulation (includes fiberglass, mineral wool, cellulose, polystyrene & newspaper insulation)
- Plastic building parts, roof vents and countertops
- Sheathing
- Molded fiberglass (resulting from building demolition/renovation)
- Rubber – no tires
- Drain tile
- Metal
- Ceiling tile*
- Wood and vinyl flooring*
- Plastic composite decking
- **Affixed** house wrap (Tyvek)

* Material containing asbestos cannot be disposed of at the demolition landfill. However, it is accepted at the MSW landfill.

Unacceptable Construction and Demolition Debris

- Material from industrial sources
- Carpet and padding rolls and large scraps
- Treated wood such as green treated and creosote
- Packaging such as cardboard boxes, shingle wrap, plastic, buckets, caulking tubes, plastic bags, shrink wrap
- Slate siding
- Food waste and beverage containers
- Tires
- Railroad ties
- Treated posts
- Oil soaked wood
- Oil impacted soil
- Highline posts
- Bridge materials
- Furniture
